RSA Legal Defense Alert!!

Always consult with an association representative/lawyer before responding to any report, letter, memo and/or questions concerning an investigation that could possibly lead to punitive action. If ordered to do so, ask to have it recorded and read the following: Non-waiver statement:

"I have been refused the right to have a representative of my choice. I understand that I am being ordered to make a report or answer questions and that, if I do not comply with the order, I may be disciplined for insubordination.

Therefore, I have no alternative but to abide by the order. However, by so doing, I do not waive my constitutional rights to remain silent under the 5th and 14th amendments to the United States Constitution and under the protections afforded me under state law."



On March 5, 2023, the RSA hosted a Concealed Carry Weapon (CCW) HR-218 retiree range qualification course at the Ben Clark Training Center (BCTC). The purpose of this event was to provide an opportunity for the retired members to possess and maintain their “CCW” and “HR-218” qualified credentials - which allows them to lawfully and legally carry firearms within the state of California - as well as nation-wide [as governed by the HR-218 standards].

The event was well attended, and the actual range qualification procedure was concise, efficient, and a quick process for those who participated. The RSA Rollin’ Smokehouse & Chow Shack was on hand to provide lunch for retirees and BCTC staff. This event was enhanced by the knowledge, hospitality, and professionalism of the BCTC CCW and range staff.

If you are interested in establishing or maintaining your HR-218 CCW permit status, we look forward to facilitating your certification at the next retiree qualification course. The next retiree qualification course has been scheduled for;

Thursday, September 12, 2024, from 10:00 AM until 2:00 PM at the Ben Clark Training Center.

Please contact the RSA office through Joey Thames [joey@rcdsa.org] to reserve your attendance by August 29, 2024.

Keep in mind that possessing the credentials to lawfully carry a concealed firearm also presents the unsolicited exposure of discharging your weapon in self-defense. In the aftermath of such an event you could face a substantial amount of money paid toward legal fees and related expenses. Please ensure that as a card-carrying CCW retiree, you have the coverage needed to protect yourself, your loved ones, and your property. There are quite a few CCW coverage plans available for vetted retirees.

The RSA Legal Defense Trust offers a CCW protection plan to active retiree members at a reasonable price. If you have any questions or concerns about the various coverage plans, please give RSA a call and ask to speak to Frank Anderson [FAnderson@rcdsa.org]. Frank is your Chapter 13 Alternate Retiree Director, and has been instrumental with the success of the CCW HR-218 course for our retirees.

Chef's Corner

Smokehouse Smoked Beans



Cook Time: 2 Hours



Prep: 30 Minutes



Serves: 12-18



Ingredients:

- 2 15oz cans of Pork & Beans
- 1 15oz can "Ranch Beans"
- 1 15oz can Dark Red Kidney Beans
- 1 15oz can Black Beans
- 1 small red or white onion (diced)
- 5 garlic cloves (minced)
- 1 green & 1 red bell pepper (diced)
- 1 Jalapeno pepper (diced) *optional
- 1/4-1 can Chipotle in Adobo sauce
- 2 cups-Golden brown sugar
- 1/4 cup worcestershire sauce *Bear and Burton's "W" sauce.
- 18oz of your favorite BBQ sauce
- 1 lb chopped BBQ brisket

Instructions:

- Step 1: Preheat smoker to 350
- Step 2: Drain beans & place in aluminum foil pan. **Important, make sure your beans are as drained as possible.
- Step 3: Remove seeds and dice peppers and onion. Place in aluminum pan
- Step 4: Mix in remainder of ingredients and mix well
- Step 5: Place pan on a cookie sheet and smoke at 325 degrees for 2 hours – you're looking for a thick chili-like consistency (the longer you cook it, the thicker it'll get – this is a reduction technique), mix every half hour
- Serve: Remove from heat and let stand 30 minutes before serving




Our famous Smokehouse beans have been a hit favorite amongst our stops along the County and RSO facilities. It is our most complimented dish the RSA

receives and serves and we get requests for the recipe time and time again. It isn't a secret so we are glad to share this recipe with you all. This recipe is a gold standard to serve alongside your favorite backyard grillin' parties or for any occasion for that matter. Just remember, the key to this is to smoke the beans uncovered in your favorite smoking vessel (Traeger or other pellet grill, Weber kettle, or traditional offset smoker) using your choice of smoking wood. The Chowshack smokes this recipe in our "Ole Hickory CTO-DW" or our "Pitmaker Vault" smokers using Post Oak wood that we get from our wood distributor who gets it straight from Texas or Oklahoma. Let us know if you need or want to try "Post Oak" and we'll gladly put you in touch with them or we can share a log or 4. The other true secret to this recipe is to add some type of smoked meat. This addition puts this bean recipe over the top. When we first started the program, we would add smoked brisket to our recipes and serve it in this ultimate way. Due to the amount of vegetarians or non-meat eaters, we've omitted any meat to our recipes, making them a true vegetarian alternative and still a crowd pleaser. Until next month, enjoy this recipe and let us know how it turns out. If any of you have any requests for future recipes, please reach out and we would be happy to share our other tried and true secrets.

How We Stand At Spring Break

Legislators in Sacramento took their “spring break” at the end of March after completing a number of policy committee hearings and acting on dozens of public safety related bills. While there are hundreds more bills impacting law enforcement and crimes when they return in early April, we are off to a pretty good start.

GOOD BILLS RECENTLY PASSED OUT OF COMMITTEE INCLUDE:

- AB 1839 (Alanis) up to \$6,000 in grants for students enrolled in a modern policing degree program at a California community college
- AB 1892 (Flora) - allows wiretaps to issue for child pornography
- AB 2336 (Villapudua) applies the current sentence for possessing firearms and dangerous narcotics (like heroin and meth) to fentanyl. This is a huge shift in the Assembly Public Safety Committee which killed an identical bill last year.
- AB 2307 (Davies) allows the victims compensation fund to pay for basic self defense classes for victims of certain crimes.



While there are hundreds more bills impacting law enforcement and crimes when they return in early April, we are off to a pretty good start.



- AB 2002 (Sanchez) requires DMV to develop a Blue Envelope Program to assist disabled persons during law enforcement stops.
- SB 933 (Wahab) clarifies that AI-generated child pornography is child pornography

AMENDED

- SB 1026 (Smallwood-Cuevas) individual law enforcement use of force standard for school districts. After we met with the Senator’s staff, the bill was

amended to remove our concerns and no longer applies to SROs or other law enforcement or school police officers. We appreciate the Senator’s willingness to consider and act on our concerns and will remove our opposition to the bill when it is heard next month.

- SB 1489 (McGuire D) as introduced, it lowered the minimum fine for conviction of felony possession of certain controlled substances to \$900. Bill amend-

ments now adjust the date for currently required report from POST to legislature, so we have changed our position to neutral.

- AB 2042 (Jackson) Law enforcement canines. Riverside County's own Assemblyman Corey Jackson is at it again trying to restrict the use of police canines. After his embarrassing defeat last year, he doubled-down and introduced AB 2042, requiring POST to ban canines in the same manner as his failed AB 742 bill did last year. Facing another expected humiliating defeat, Jackson recently amended his bill to require POST to develop standards based on "best practices" (undefined) when using K9s for pursuit of

violent criminals, non-violent criminals, crowd control, and procedures to minimize harm to innocent bystanders. We remain opposed to this bill due to the author's stated goal of banning police canines.

PRO-CRIMINAL / BAD BILLS

- AB 2709 (Bonta) creates a right to jail inmate visits, regardless of violent or dangerous inmate or visitor behavior outside of visiting rooms.
- AB 3021 (Kalra) requires Miranda-type warnings from officers before interviewing witnesses or family members of persons seriously injured or killed by law enforcement
- AB 2923 (Jones-Sawyer) allows public to knowingly false complaints about officers

- AB 3127 (McKinnor) protects and enables repeat and violent abusers by eliminating requirement that medical mandated reporters notify law enforcement for suspected serious domestic violence, sexual assault, abuse, etc.
- SB 1160 (Portantino) requires every privately-owned firearm to be registered with the state DOJ on an annual basis and that the owner pay a registration fee for each one. To answer your question, yes. This currently requires all firearms owned by peace officers to be registered and pay a fee for each.

These and most of the more than 300 other bills we are tracking in 2024 must be approved by the policy committee deadline of April 26 or they will die.

Making a false or fraudulent worker's compensation claim is a felony subject to up to 5 years in prison or a fine of up to \$50,000 or double the value of the fraud, whichever is greater, or by both imprisonment and fine.
