RIVERSIDE SHERIFFS' ASSOCIATION LAUNCHES AN INJURY / RETIREMENT HOTLINE

Effective immediately, all RSA members, active or retired, now have access to the Law Offices of Hayes & Cunningham, RSA's General Counsel, to answer questions about their injury and retirement issues. Specifically, any member who may have questions about Workers Compensation* or work related injuries, off duty injuries, disability retirement questions, auto accidents and any personal injury claim can call the RSA Hotline and receive information about their rights and obligations following an injury.

Attorneys with decades of experience handling these types of cases will provide expert advice. By calling the Hotline, members will also have access to a menu of general information that will answer most common questions dealing with injury claims.

Topics include:

- How do I file a worker's compensation claim?
- How do I get Medical attention?
- How do I get paid when I am off work recovering?
- What happens if the doctor says that I can never return to work?

Remember, the RSA is sponsoring the service so there is no fee or cost associated with calling the Hotline. Attorneys will also be available, at a discounted rate, if you wish to retain one to assist you in your case.

Please be advised that the use of the Hotline does not establish an attorney-client relationship. Additionally, contact by email or telephone does not establish an attorney-client relationship. Unless and until a fee agreement/fee disclosure as required by the State of California is signed by both the injured worker or member and an attorney, there is no formal attorney-client relationship established.

*NOTICE: Making a false or fraudulent workers' compensation claim is a felony subject to up to 5 years in prison or a fine of up to \$50,000 or double the value of the fraud, whichever is greater, or by both imprisonment and fine.
