RE: AB 1671, As Amended, March 10, 2010 – SUPPORT

Dear Assemblymember Jeffries:

The Riverside Sheriffs' Association, which represents over 3,200 rank and file deputy sheriffs, deputy probation officers, law enforcement investigators and counselors, coroners and bailiffs – the entire law enforcement team in Riverside County – supports your bill, AB 1671.

AB 1671 authorizes a Board of Supervisors to fill a board vacancy within 90 days from the date of vacancy with reconciling provisions if such appointment is not made in a timely manner. Currently, the Board of Supervisors of a charter county may fill a vacancy, but a Board of Supervisors of a general law county may not. AB 1671 conforms current law applicable to charter counties to general law counties thereby helping ensure local control and better decision making.
